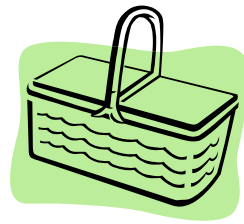

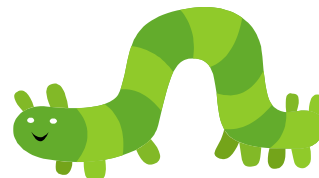
Job Opportunity - Bookkeeper

FINANCIAL YEAR END JUNE 30TH! - Our Financial year was moved to the end of June. We have a budget of \$272,243 and through your generous giving and our rental income we have raised \$242,302 as of June 1. We need an additional \$29,941 in the next four weeks to meet the budget, or a weekly offering of \$7,500. My best estimate is that our expenses will be about \$6,200 below budget, thus reducing the weekly offering needed to about \$5,900. Please consider what you can give in the next three weeks to help us meet our budget and hopefully have a small surplus. Tim Sauer, Treasurer
